Period: November 2025 – June 2026

Frequency: one day per week (e.g. every Wednesday)

Purpose: To promote kindness, empathy and solidarity among students, teachers and the school community.

Description: Each week, the school will mark 'Kindness Day', a day dedicated to positive gestures, non-violent communication and encouraging mutual respect.

Week	Proposed activity	Description/purpose	Responsible
1	Smile for my colleague	Students offer compliments or positive messages to their classmates.	Form tutors, school counsellor
2	Gratitude box	A collective box where students leave thank-you notes.	School counsellor, support teachers
3	I help a colleague	Support campaign among students (tutoring, homework, organisation).	Form teachers, student volunteers
4	Cleanliness of kindness	Classroom or schoolyard cleaning activity.	Form teachers, sports teachers
5	No criticism day	A day when the entire school community focuses on positive expression.	All teachers
6	Anonymous gift of kindness	Students secretly give a note or a small positive symbol to a classmate.	Erasmus team
7	Friendly greeting	Exercise in friendly greetings between classes.	Conductors
8	Surprise teacher	Students write appreciation notes for teachers.	The Erasmus team

This recurring activity contributes to creating a positive school atmosphere, reduces tensions and complements all other Erasmus activities by constantly encouraging empathetic and respectful behaviour.
